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Beloved, when we go through the scriptures, it is evident that no man can achieve any great feat without adequate preparation. The concept of preparation has been around since the dawn of time. Proverbs 6:6-8 tells us that it is wise to make provisions for the future. These, alongside many instances in the Bible, have shown us that setting time apart to spend with God through prayer and fasting is an important tool to unlocking heaven's resources for a new season.

This is what this devotional helps to provide for you and your family. It is a day to day spiritual treat to help guide you through the 21-day prayer and fasting as we prepare for an amazing new year. Please commit yourself to the daily prayers, confessions and declarations because they have the capacity to mould your year in line with God's word.

Finally, I charge you to follow this devotional daily and all other resources provided with rugged faith and a heart ready to receive from God and you will experience all that He has promised you this year.

Effective Prayer and Fasting.

However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.

Matthew 17:21 (NKJV) _____

One of the things fasting delivers to you is that it takes your attention from self and humanity and places your entire focus on divinity (God). Fasting strips you of every sense of ownership and control to change the situations within and around you but helps you concentrate and connect with God on a deeper and more intimate level.

It's like writing an examination in school, not all subjects/Courses will get the same attention. For instance, Mathematics was a subject most people dreaded when we were younger even till now, but it was mandatory for us to pass it before we made progress in our academic pursuits. For some, it required they put in extra effort by paying a private tutor to teach and further expound the calculations and principles, while for others, simply spent more time practicing questions in order to gain mastery of problems that will be given during the examination helped a lot in understanding the subject; (of course nobody wanted to repeat a class because of mathematics alone). Whatever the case was, we gave Mathematics more attention compared to other subjects.

In the same vein, when it comes to gaining mastery over some key areas in life, there is the need to devote attention to seeking out what God's direction is, what steps we need to take, and the effective ways to go about it, and this we do when we fast and pray. It is accurate to say that combining fasting and praying produces speedy answers and effective results. Here are some of the ways to make your Prayer and Fasting effective:

- [a]. Find out from the scriptures what the Word says concerning your situation. You can have 3-5 scriptures for each of the areas.
- [b]. Continually meditate on those scriptures; think deeply on them and let the Holy Spirit give you insights
- [c]. Have a consistent prayer plan. Join NLP with Pastor Bolaji, actively participate in the 1pm prayers and have a private prayer time.

- [e]. Stay in the mood of thanksgiving. We recommend you schedule praise breaks in your day.

It's safe to seek for clarity or direction from someone who is very familiar with the path to my destination. Who else does the job of a life tour guide than the person who created you from your mother's womb and has already mapped out the best plans for your life (Jeremiah 1:5), (Psalms 139:13) Creator of the Universe which is God Almighty.

You can receive solutions, clarity and directions from God in these 3 simple ways:

[a.] Simply ask him-The bible says in James 1:5-6 we should ask for wisdom in prayers. It's that simple, just ask in faith. Open your mouth and ask him for anything and everything it doesn't matter how wise or foolish it may sound **JUSK ASK IN FAITH.**

[b.] Listen to what God is saying- Prayer is a 2-way communication not a one-way traffic. God always has something to say but are we positioned to listen or expecting answers from him. (Habakkuk 2:1-Easy To Read Version says "I will wait and learn how he answers my questions") God is not a man and there is a how to the way he answers our questions.

[c.] Do what he says you should do- I think this is the part that most of us struggle the most because for the lack of better words we don't have a definite outcome using the human mind or senses. Sometimes what God may ask you to do doesn't make sense thinking about it. The bible says in 2 Cor 5:7 "For we walk by faith not by sight". God will never lead you wrongly and he will also never leave you stranded (Psalms 23)

Let me end on this note, Trust and Obey for there is no other way to be happy in Jesus but to trust and Obey, this song is valid till eternity. Jer 29:11- Voice Translation "For I know the plans I have for you says the Eternal, plans for peace, not evil, to give you a future and a hope – never forget that".

Ephesians 2:8. You have the same faith as Jesus Christ who raised Lazarus from the dead. Galatians 2:20

Faith always works! 1 John 5:4. Your faith overcomes infertility, your faith overcomes delay, your faith overcomes poverty, and limitation. Your faith is the God kind of faith. There's nothing wrong with your faith, and there's nothing wrong with God, but how about your prayers?

Wrong believe can affect the way you pray, it will bring wrong thinking and wrong thinking will bring wrong prayers. James 4:3. your believe is negative, your prayer will be negative because everything rests on your believe. All things are possible to all who believe. Your believe is a container of how much God can do in your life. Mark 9:23

What you believe determines what happens to you, not what you desire. The Bible says that the expectation of the righteous shall not be cut shut. Your believe system is very powerful because your daily life acts out what you believe in. And as you go through your stages in life, you will begin to drop what you don't believe in bit by bit. 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Overcoming limiting beliefs and mindset.

Jesus said, take away the stones. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he has been dead for four days.

John 11v 39

Limiting beliefs are thoughts, convictions, or opinions that we believe to be absolute truths that hold us back in some shape or form. As a result, they prevent us from growing, achieving our goals, taking risks or new opportunities, or becoming the people we want to be or that God wants us to be.

In John 11v39, the story there shows how the people couldn't see the miraculous because of the "stone", the stone here being the limiting mindset. The stone had to be moved for the power of God to manifest. Our mindset can either be a conductor of God's power or an insulator of God's power.

The bible chronicles the stories of people who had beliefs and mindset that limited them from seeing the miraculous. When our mindset aligns with God, great things happen!

The first step to overcoming limiting belief is to identify what those beliefs are and deliberately and consciously work towards changing it. The beliefs can be cultural in nature; some can be based on your past experiences in life; others can be unhealthy thoughts picked up on social media, or even inspired by the people around you.

Once they have been identified, you need to then start confessing what God's word says about you and those situations. For example, if you find yourself constantly thinking that you are limited because of your life experiences or background, you can start confessing that "you are the head and not the tail" (Job 22:29) and that the favor of God encompasses you like a shield (Psalms 5:12), therefore you are preferred by all.

The Bible speaks of the renewal of our mind and that's the way we begin to replace limiting beliefs and mindset with that of God's. Our thoughts get elevated, aligns with that of God's and the action steps that would bring about the miracle we want is downloaded into our spirit and ultimately there is a performance.

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How to change your outcome by faith.

For verily I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall whatsoever he saith.

The entire Christian life is a Faith-based life from the very beginning of it, spanning every and any stage you find yourself in.

You need faith to accept Jesus Christ into your life as the Son of God and that He died and resurrected from death for remission of our sin. This singular beginner's faith journey assures your victory over the world as we get to see in 1John 5: 4(KJV) for example. This step alone translates one from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of light- outcomes changed immediately

From the paragraph above, we can posit that every outcome in our lives can be altered for the better through faith. A key pain point for the modern-day Christian is the puzzling reality of how despite the claims and confessions of faith made, they continue to wallow in the crippling situation they find themselves. Fundamentally, there is a disconnect between what is been believed and what is being confessed, hence the dissonance

In the kingdom that we belong, Faith is our never-failing currency to purchase our entry into our desired promises at any stage of our lives. In Hebrews 11:1 (amp), faith literally was denoted as a "title deed" which means evidence that you have already paid for something yet to arrive in the sense realm.

The way to change unfavorable situations is to first search out what God's word says in that situation, meditate on it until light comes, then begin to confess the word and superimpose on the negative situation, what you want to see. Believe that you have received in thanksgiving, and you will turn that situation around in Jesus' name. Philippians 4:6 assures us of this. In verse 7 of Philippians 4, we clearly see that we need to come to the place of prayer without fear and anxiety. Satan will throw negative evidence in the physical realm at you to test your faith but remember that God also spoke light to come out right amid darkness in the beginning. Do like God and obtain your reward. Notice that God did not dwell on the darkness but spoke what He wants during chaos.

In conclusion, some situations will require prayers and fasting and faith to change them as you see in Mark 9: 29. Build your faith through the infallible Word of God, pray, fast, and declare what you want and that negative issue in business, health, career, politics, education e.t.c will be turned to the outcome you desire to see today.

Our giving is also proof of our love. We cannot claim to love and not be generous, because the first proof of God's love for mankind was His willingness to give His only son as a ransom for our redemption.

Finally, our generosity activates the law of sowing and reaping and creates a pathway for us to be blessed by God and helped by other people. Proverbs 11:25 says "The generous soul will be made rich, and he who waters will also be watered himself."

God wants to bless and increase you, so that through you the world will be blessed. Are you going to partner with Him through your generosity, or will find an excuse not to be a giver?

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The Reward of Generosity.

Give and it shall be given unto you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be out into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.

Luke 6:38

When God asks us to do something, we must remember that although we may be doing it for Him, we are ultimately the biggest beneficiaries of our obedience. A case in point is our generosity. There are numerous examples in the scriptures where God instructs us to live generous lives. In today's devotional, we will consider what some of the rewards of generosity are.

1. Giving results in receiving. Jesus himself said Luke 6:38, "Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal [measure] it shall be measured to you again." The bible also teaches in 2 Corinthians 9:6 that the quality of our giving is tied to the quality of our harvest.
2. Giving adds to your account: People often see giving as something that takes away from them, but that's an inaccurate perspective. In Philippians 4:17, we see that our giving actually results in a credit to our spiritual account.
3. Giving helps us access divine blessings: When we respond in generosity to God, we position ourselves to access His blessings on earth. In Malachi 3, God promises us that when we give, He will open the windows of heaven over us. Do you want to access God's blessings for your life? Make a choice to live a generous life.
4. Giving increases our faith. Our generosity is a proof of our trust in God. The more you trust God, the more you will give. And the more you give, the more you learn to trust God that you will have enough left over for your own needs. Our trusting God is so big in God's mind that our finances is the only place He allows us to test Him, as seen in Malachi 3:10.
5. Our generosity results in thanksgiving and praise. God doesn't want to bring you a financial blessing just so you can sit on a fat bank account and gloat about what you have. He wants you to be generous with others, and as you do so, their thanksgiving will go up to God on your behalf. Is your wealth a source of thanksgiving to the Lord? If not, then you're not using your finances correctly.

God wants to bless so many of His children, but until we partner with Him through our generosity, we may find ourselves living sub-optimal lives.

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Dealing with spiritual barriers.

For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

Mark 11 vs 23

A barrier is anything built or serving as an obstacle/ limitation, to prevent movement or access. Something like a gate at a car park, a roadblock, fence, blockade, bar, or barricade. In our day to day lives, a barrier could also be a circumstance, challenge, complication or difficulty that restrains or obstructs progress.

God's constant intention is for us to grow. (Proverbs 4:18) and move forward. When Moses asked the children of Israel to stand still, God's instruction was 'Let the people move forward' (Exodus 13:14-15). What a beautiful plan our master has for us. HALLELUJAH!! Its however a different experience for some people. no matter how they try, there is little or no progress. They find themselves stuck in a vicious circle, moving from one problem to another; one failure to another or just going round the same Mountain (Deuteronomy 2:2) To make reasonable progress, we must overcome the barriers that oppose us. Ephesians 6:12. Gives us a clear description of the opposition/adversary. While 2 Corinthians 10:3- 4, states the kind of weapons available in our arsenal. In order to prevail, we must be fit, trained and well equipped. Jesus emphasized the importance of spiritual food when he was tempted by Satan: "Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God" (Matthew 4:4).

Beloved! Barriers can be pushed, jumped over, ran through or carried (moved out of the way). Only the word can give you the required fitness to do that. Another way to deal with spiritual barriers can be found in the example of Jericho in front of the children of Israel, as they marched into their inheritance. "Now Jericho was securely shut up because of the children of Israel; none went out, and none came in." (Joshua 6:1). God gave an instruction, they obeyed to the letter, the walls fell and they gained access into the city (Joshua 6:20). One major thing to note here as regards dealing with spiritual barriers is 'Complete obedience to God's instruction' weather it makes sense or not. Another example is apostle Peter's prison break. "Peter was therefore kept in prison, but CONSTANT prayer was offered to God for him by the church." (Acts 12:5). The outcome was that an angel went to rescue him. When the church prayed gates were opened. Note that prayer was made consistently. It does not matter the types of barriers we face in our lives God and our faith in God can tear down any obstacle.

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Developing a growth plan.

Wise people are builders — they build families, businesses, communities. And through intelligence and insight their enterprises are established and endure. Because of their skilled leadership, the hearts of people are filled with the treasures of wisdom and the pleasures of spiritual wealth.

Proverbs 24:3-4 TPT

A growth plan is a blueprint or a strategy about the goals you have set for yourself and how you aim to achieve them. As a believer, you cannot succeed without God in your plan and without a plan, you are going nowhere.

As God's people we ought to expect growth as a normal part of the Christian life, we see this in the book of Acts 6:1.

This growth should not be accidental but intentional and it will take prayer, work and time.

In Genesis as God was working on creation, when it was time to make man, He said "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth" Genesis 1:26. This sentence depicts planning, a strategy on what He expected man ought to look like and what man ought to achieve. Jesus speaking said "for which of you, desiring to build a tower, does not first sit down and count the cost" Luke 14:28. This verse shows that developing a growth plan is important as believers, we know and believe God to be a God of process. A plan is all about following processes and steps mapped out.

John 15:2 tells us how much God is invested in our growth, so much so that He grooms and prunes us regularly. He does not want you to be the same person you have always been for years. You have to make spiritual progress and advancement each day of your life. You need to live an ever increasing and improving life. Determine that from today, you will develop a growth plan and follow it through.

There are three cardinal principles we must remember in developing our plan,

1. Do it right: this involves setting goals, adopting strategies and evaluating progress.
2. Targeting the individual need.
3. Paying the price: Submission, service and sacrifice

Just as we get hungry for food, we should be hungry for the word of God.

In the passage above, Jesus was tempted three times and in all cases, He overcame with the word He knew. This tells us it is not enough to read the bible without committing the Word into our heart. Having the word of God helps us overcome the devil and his plans (sin or challenges) (Psalm 119:11). We can only have the word in us if we are hungry for it. Study it and allow the word become flesh in us.

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How to discern God's Voice.

And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again.

Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the word of the LORD yet revealed unto him. And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child.

Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and lay down in his place. And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth..

1st Samuel 3:6 - 10

One of the most important and yet illusive concepts in Christianity is the ability to discern God's voice. Many Christians today are very confused when it comes to discerning God's voice, because God is spiritual and rarely communicates with us through our physical senses, most of our interactions with God is based on our ability to discern him spiritually. This makes it difficult for us who have always relied on our physical senses to discern our environment.

We have a God that wants to be known and has made it very easy for us to discern His Voice. There is a saying that goes "start from the known to the unknown", God has done just that. Since we rely primarily on our physical senses, God has put everything thing that we need to know about him in his Word (The Bible). God expects us to start by reading his word and becoming familiar with is person and character, so that when he begins to speak to we will begin to understand how he speaks, the content of what he will Say and what He will never say. We can be sure that God will never say anything that contradicts His word, so the more you are familiar with the Word, the more you will be able to discern Gods Voice.

There are other ways to discern God's voice, and that is fellowship with people, people who are now more experienced in discerning God's voice. Notice in the opening scripture that Eli taught Samuel how to recognize and respond to the voice of God, without Eli, Samuel probably would have missed the opportunity to recognize God's voice and to respond to it.

God's wants to speak to us and we must be very confident in this. But God's voice must be discerned spiritually and this can be done by studying his Word and in fellowship with other believers.

The above scripture clearly states that God is looking for people and also states His requirements. A lot of times we are under the impression that God's standard is so high that no human can qualify to be used by God. On the contrary the criteria for being used by God is quite simple, God is looking for a person whose heart is perfect towards Him.

Let's break this down a little bit more, God isn't looking for a perfect person, he is looking for someone whose heart is perfect towards Him, as a matter of fact, we can say that he perfects the ones who he has called! In order to understand this scripture a little more let's look at the MSG version.

GOD is always on the alert, constantly on the lookout for people who are totally committed to him. You were foolish to go for human help when you could have had God's help. Now you're in trouble—one round of war after another."

God is looking for commitment to him and not perfection, God his saying it doesn't matter what you have done or the mistakes you will make as long as you don't forsake him in the same way he will never forsake you. **Hebrews 13:5** – This is our sure and confident assurance, the expression of His love for us.

Our relationship with God is like a marriage, it's for better or for worse in the good times and in the bad. God knows this but most of the time we are under the impression that God is looking for perfection when he is looking for COMMITMENT!

David is the best example of this, God said David is a man after my heart, but David made many mistakes but God made this statement about him still. This is because David never forsook God even in the most trying times he always sought God.

My brothers and Sisters, the criteria for God to use you is just for you to be committed to the relationship! Stick with God no matter what and live the rest to Him. Never let anyone or any thought make you feel like you are not worthy of His love – He loves you just the way you are and is willing to use you as a mighty tool in His hands.

Identity is a huge concept in psychology, because people's choices come from their identity, if you identify as an Doctor you tend to think like a doctor and make choices based on the fact that you are a doctor, if you identify as a Man you tend to think like a man and make choices as a man. Your Identity is a motivation for what you do and do not do.

When Paul the apostle was writing the above scripture he was dealing with sexual immorality in the Corinthian church, and his point was that, if you know that you are one with the Spirit and the spirit is Holy you will not join yourself to a Harlot. Another way to look at this, if you identify as someone who is very neat and clean you will always keep yourself from dirt and stains, Identity plays a big role in our lives and controls our choices.

Identifying with God, helps you understand that you have access to everything that God has access to, you have access to His righteousness (you are even referred to as His righteousness), you have access to His power and authority – and this becomes a game changer!

This means that at every point in time, you can make choices that are in tandem with what He will make because you have the Holy Spirit sitting in you and expressing Himself through you. This is the amazing life we have in Him!

Jesus said to the people you are God's, in doing this he was trying to influence their identity and let them know that the same perspective God has is what we should have. When we face challenges, we should not be overwhelmed or daunted by the situation if we identify with the Spirit of God. The Spirit was given to help us, to strengthen us and to remind us of who we are in Christ. When you are able to do this you will always be victorious in all that you do.

Most Christians are yet to unravel the limitless possibilities that we have access to as a result of the Holy Spirit living inside of us. The Holy Spirit is the very Spirit of God and He has access to all God has access to; He can do all God can do, and He chooses to dwell within us with all the riches of God's glory.

The challenge is that most times, our finiteness and limitations can serve as a barrier that caps the whole expression of the Holy Spirit inside of us. I once read an inscription that says "It is inconceivable to think that the same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead dwells in us only to heal headaches"

Truth is, most times, our limitations and immediate environments, circumstances and needs make us reduce His expression in our lives to healing us of headaches and other mundane things; think of it this way:

In a building, the same electricity that flows into a house to power Air conditioners and a microwave oven, is the same that can be channeled to boil water with an electric cooker or power on a decoder; and also the same electricity from the distribution company is the one that goes on to power a stadium; meaning there's no limit to the power generated and expressed, rather, the limiting factor can be the channel (or the vessel) as the case may be.

In the same vein, the same power of God that is present to cure cancer, is the same that is available to cure a headache, or even take the whole world for Jesus, and even rest on a business man to make deals worth millions of dollars; the possibilities of the Holy Spirit is limitless; but it's expression can be limited by us – the carriers and the channels.

The Spirit manifest in different way in order to achieve His purpose on the earth. One of the functions of the Spirit is to confirm the Word of God with signs and wonders.

As you yield to the sway of the Spirit in your life, there's no telling how mightily He'd use you. Beyond inspiring and blessing you, He can use you to accomplish mighty feats of power in the spirit. Right in your closet, as you pray by the Holy Ghost, you can touch lives and change things thousands of miles away Hallelujah!

How Faith Comes (Part 1)

Romans 10:9

A good understanding of how faith comes is important for a victorious Christian life. Faith is unarguably the most important asset of a believer. There are numerous passages in the bible that corroborates this assertion and we shall look at some in today's devotional.

Salvation, the most important provision of God to redeem man from sin is not possible without faith. Apostle Paul lends credence to this with his epistles to the believers at Ephesus and Corinth:

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God." - Ephesians 2:8

"If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." - Romans 10:9

Similarly, a walk with God is not possible without faith.

"But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." - Hebrews 11:6

Having established why we must pay attention to the subject of faith, let's delve into how it comes.

"So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." - Romans 10:17

Faith comes by hearing and believing the word of God. We got saved by hearing the message on salvation and believed it. Consequently, we acted on the message by confessing the Lordship of Jesus.

Although faith is a universal principle, faith in one area of life doesn't necessary connote faith in all other areas. Through consistent hearing of the word of God on finances, some are able to believe God for finances and have achieved tremendous success in this regard. If you need faith for finances, you'll have to hear the word of God on finances, meditate and act on it. Similarly, if you need faith in the area of healing, you need to hear the word of God concerning your health, believe and act on it.

Faith looks beyond impossibilities and pictures the desired state before the change manifests. If you will receive faith for victory in any area of your life, this must be your approach.

"While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal." - 2 Corinthians 4:18

Let's look at the account of the impotent man at Lystra that received his healing and the salvation experience of Cornelius.

There are valuable lessons we can learn to build faith in any area we desire:

1. The man heard the word
2. The man believed the word
3. The man received faith and acted on it by leaping and walking

Let's look at the account of the centurion at Capernaum

Mathew 8:5-10

"And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him, And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented'. And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.

The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldst come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it.

When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel!" There are valuable lessons and deductions we can make from the passage that can help immensely to receive faith in any area we desire:

1. The centurion had heard Jesus preach and minister to the sick or else he wouldn't have approached him to heal his servant
2. The centurion believed the word of God was able to heal his servant hence the reason he told Jesus to speak the word
3. Jesus acknowledged in verse 10 that the man had faith

I believe God will empower you for an encounter of a lifetime and you'll have remarkable testimonies.

Believe God. Believe what His word says about you, about the mountain, what God has told you personally. Believe Him and hold unto His word.

2. Faith that can move mountains is faith that confesses positively.

Not only do I believe it, I confess it. What God says about me, what God has told me, what I desire to see, I confess it.

From the story of creation, the Bible says in Genesis 1: 2 – 4 "The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light."

The earth was without form and void but God wanted light and he called it forth, and there was light.

In the story of the Shunamite woman in 2 Kings 4, even with a dead child, the woman confessed to everyone that it is well, it will be well and it was well.

Faith that will move mountains is faith that confesses what you want to see and not the circumstances of the mountain.

5. Faith that move mountains stays joyful and thankful at all times because it knows that maintaining a state of thanksgiving is a high display of confidence in God.

This is because you can believe the word, confess the word, take steps, and still not see what you desire yet. The Bible says in Ephesians 6:13 "Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand."

Therefore, concerning that mountain in your life, find out what the Bible says about it and what God is saying to you personally. Confess what you want to see, take a step of faith concerning it and then be ready to stand having done all these. The mountain will definitely move and be cast into the sea in Jesus name.

I trust God that He will move every mountain that has defied all in your life and give you a testimony that will bring glory to His name in Jesus name.

Be intentional about studying the bible and your spiritual life will take off. If there is anything you should not leave to chance for the sake of your spiritual wellbeing it is the quantity and quality of time spent digging the scriptures. In a world where everything seems to be fast and rising, many Christians have left the studying of their bible to chance, to Sunday or weekly service. Christians like that would only end up becoming spiritually malnourished. To study your bible effectively is to obey a biblical commandment, and to do otherwise because of whatsoever excuse is to disobey that command. Just as you need physical food on a daily basis to sustain the flesh, a Christian needs enough of the word of God to sustain the spirit daily.

Do you know that no matter how busy a man gets during the day, he still finds time to eat? Why? Because the body needs the food to continue. Such is the place of studying God's word daily to keep our spirit man alert and to hear from God. Thy words were found, and I did eat them (Jer. 15:16a). You must realize that it takes a hunger for God's word, not just sermons for a man to be able to come to a place of studying the bible effectively. You must desire to know the mind of God directly, what is God's perspective on issues of life? The bible offers every detail of it. The hunger for God's word will make studying the word not a boring and ritualistic exercise as a Christian but an avenue to hear God speak to you directly. If you are finding it hard to settle and find time for your bible, pray to God to increase your hunger for His word. This is only for those that sincerely want to improve in their bible study life. The psalmist says a broken and a contrite heart the Lord will not despise.

And be not conformed to this world; but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind; that ye may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God (Romans 12:2).

When you study your bible, your mind gets renewed which breeds transformation into more of Christ's stature. Be encouraged to set out a time daily on God's word, preferably during the early hours of the day or at night, please don't confuse this with morning devotion. It can be incorporated into morning devotion, but it must involve the whole of your heart, with the bible like a student to his books. You can get a journal and a pen to note down bible scriptures, if possible, write out striking scriptures and lessons and directions received from studying the bible. You can assist your study with bible study outlines or guide from church. Remember it is bible study, not bible reading. Studying can involve comparing scriptures, memorizing scriptures, understanding scriptures and resolving how to apply the lessons learnt to one's life which is the major essence of studying. The word of God is quick and sharper than any two-edged sword, it reveals yourself to you like a man beholds a mirror. It is your sword against the devil. Remember how Jesus defeated the temptation from Satan? He didn't negotiate, he gave the devil scriptures and that was all (Matt. 4:1-11). Don't be without a Word when you face temptation from the devil. But how will you offer what you haven't filled yourself with? Your word have I hid in my heart that I shall not sin against thee (Psalm 119:11).

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Becoming a living sacrifice.

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Galatians 2:20

The word 'living sacrifice' is a bit of a contradiction. The word sacrifices connotes that the subject matter is dead, and yet the word 'living' is added to it. What does this mean?

The first part of Gal 2:20 says, "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless, I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me" - KJV

I have died. Yet I live. But it's not really me that lives. It's Christ that lives in me. The life in me belongs to Christ. I 'lost' my life and Christ gave me His own, or Christ lives His life through me as my own life is no more.

Have you ever borrowed clothes for a party? You would not move around freely, and you would be very conscious of where you sit etc. You are in a peculiar position. Other guests at the party believe the clothes are yours but, they are not really yours. You know they are not yours

When Adam sinned, he (Adam) lost the presence of God. He 'died'. But when Christ came, He (Christ) brought back the presence so now we 'live'. So as believers the state we are in is that we are 'dead' to our old self but alive to Him. Unbelievers might think our lives belong to us, but we know that is not true.

But just like the person that borrowed clothes to a party, there is a tendency to forget that the 'clothes' are not ours and that we will have to give 'account' to the owner of the clothes. As Christians we must always live with the consciousness that the life we live is not ours. We must continually die to self that we may live for Him. Luke 9:23 calls it carrying our cross daily. The cross represents death, so it says for us to 'kill' the old self daily. How you we do this?

The flesh loves to feed the senses (sight, taste, touch, sound, smell). The flesh wants to indulge in excesses (food, sleep, fun activities etc). But we constantly subdue these tendencies by feeding our Spirit instead (the word, prayers, worship, fasting, meditation, and fellowship with believers etc).

Please note that it is not a one-off thing. It is daily, a habit. It is not just about doing a 7-day dry fast. It is about living a 'fasted' life. It is not just about praying all night once. It is about living a prayerful life.

Will you take up your cross today?
And then tomorrow, and the day after...?
The Spirit of God beckons!

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Constantly burning for God.

Because zeal for Your house has eaten me up, and the reproaches of those who reproach You have fallen on me.

Psalm 69:9

Have you ever seen people that love each other? The first thing you will notice is that they are always communicating. They are always in touch – visits, calls, messages etc. They will talk about practically anything. The fact that they are talking even becomes more important than what is being talked about.

Our relationship with God should follow a similar pattern. He loves us and is always eager to communicate with us. As we open our hearts to Him love our relationship with him deepens. Communication becomes more and more seamless. Things that are not immediately obvious also happen:

- His nature rubs off on us and we become more and more like him in nature - Our thoughts, reasoning, response to situations, humility, love, faith etc. 2 Corinthians 3:18
- Because we become more like him, we command more respect in the spiritual realm. Acts 19:15
- We notice that we obtain more results in our day-to-day life. We are more and more able to deploy His power for results in our lives - Hebrews 11:32-34

We find that the need to gratify self keeps going down and it's now all about pleasing Him. Ego is tossed out.

This is what happens when we are burning for God. We move from 'All that matters is me' to 'All that matters is God'. Jesus called John the Baptist a 'burning and shining light' (John 5:35). This is what John said in John 3:30 - He must increase, but I must decrease.

This is the essence of burning for God. It's not in the shouts. It's not in the physical demonstration. It is not in calling down fire from heaven. It is in you decreasing so that He may increase.

Are you burning for God?

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Understanding your identity in Christ.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

2 Corinthians 5:17

Identity is the distinguishing character or personality of an individual. When someone asks, identify yourself, they are simply asking, who are you?

Many years ago, in school, I was a member of a secret cult. When we travelled to other schools, we would use some gestures and codes to identify ourselves to our members in that school. We would also identify our rank in the system. This determines what kind of reception we got, people we could meet, places we could go to, etc

In life, identity is a big deal. If you walk into the airport, who you are determines where you can go. You can fly the plane if you are the pilot, search others if you are security, walk through customs without hassles if you are a VIP, etc. Your identity tells everyone who you are, what you can do, what access you have, what authority you have, etc.

So now that you are born again what does this mean? Who are you?

- You are a child of God – John 1:12
- You are enabled to bear fruits – John 15:16
- You are special – 1 Pet 2:9
- You are 'manufactured' to do good works – Ephesians 2:10
- You are a citizen of Heaven - Philippians 3:20
- You are a replica of Jesus – 1 John 4:17

However, the way identity works, you must know who you are to be able to engage external circumstances accordingly. You must know you are a pilot to be able to confidently walk towards the cockpit of the plane. If you do not know who you are, then it is all a big waste.

Do you know who you are in Christ?

One core ministry of the Holy Spirit in our lives is to teach us who we are in Christ – John 16:13-14.

2 Corinthians 3:18 captures this so beautifully. As you behold/contemplate, you get transformed. Your work is to behold. His work is to transform. Joshua 1:8 captures the same essence

You must allow the Spirit to work in you, by making your heart a fertile place for His work. You do this by simply filling your heart with the raw materials he needs – the word, worship, your meditation, confession, etc. Be conscious of the atmosphere you create in your heart by the things you expose your heart to - Proverbs 4:23

As you do this you will be amazed at the transformation you will experience. Praise God!

A father is the head of his household, but once outside the house the dynamics may change. He could bark commands at the kids at home, but humbly take orders from the boss at work. The difference? Authority!

Authority is the 'right' to make decisions, give orders and enforce obedience. Authority is the essence of our lordship in Christ. It is the stuff kings are made of.

Many years ago, I was a boarding student. I walked into the hostel one Sunday evening and saw my bunkmate opening a pack of cabin biscuits. I was hungry so and hoped he would give me some. He casually looked up and asked if I wanted some. I said yes! He invited me. I took one, then two and then three biscuits. I said thank you and made ready to leave thinking I would be overstepping my boundary if I continued. Then he casually said, "Er your elder brother visited. We looked for you but could not find you, so he asked me to give you these biscuits...."

Yes Christ has come
Yes He has died
Yes He is risen
Yes He is seated in God above all powers and principalities

But what does this mean for us? This means He has fully paid the price for Adam's disobedience, displaced the devil from the position Adam gave him, and fully restored our original God given rights – right to access and use the power that God wields, right to rule and dominate our world, right to be all that God wants us to be!

You see the devil wants to keep eating the biscuit of your peace and prosperity. He does not want you to know that it is yours by right. He wants you to keep begging for bits instead of demanding for the whole pack! The opening scripture talks about gods dying like mere men for one simple reason, they know NOT (vs 5). What a waste.

But when you understand who you are in Christ, you take your rightful place and bring the glory of God into your world and environment. You become an effective minister of the gospel. God is honored this way.

Conclusion: To walk in this Authority, it is very important to understand it and enforce it.

Understand - A revelation that comes from exposure to the word of God and not just head knowledge. This is very spiritual. As expose your heart to the word (study, listening to messages etc) God shows you who you are in Christ. 2Cor3:18,

Enforce – In prayer make demands in faith and according to the revelation of who you are in Christ and take down every opposition by your words. Opposition could be thoughts/mindsets or demonic influences. 2Cor10:5

A king might make a statement and his subjects would say "but sir...". But when the king stands his ground, everyone bows. This is exactly what happens as you understand and enforce. All 'buts' in your life will bow.

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Vision

Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he.

Proverbs 29 vs18

When it comes to achieving things in life, most people are content and happy with themselves if they can just see things through. Their being able to say they would do something and then achieve that thing is hailed by many. And that is truly commendable, but very few people take the time to see through things. The ability to see things through would make many people successful in most circles but it is the ability to see through things that makes us significant as believers.

Jesus Christ demonstrated the ability to see through things which is that ability to recognize, identify, and understand what was happening below the surface of occurrences and situations. In Luke 19:1-10. Jesus had just finished doing miracles on the way to Jericho, and as he entered Jericho with a crowd surrounding him, probably hoping for more miracles or even some free bread and fish, Jesus saw Zacchaeus. Zacchaeus was not the kind of man that Jesus should be identifying with in a crowd of Jews. Zacchaeus was hated and for good reason, as he was a tax collector for the oppressive Romans. But Jesus saw through it all and followed the work of his vision. And he said in Luke 1: 10, "for the Son of Man is come to seek and to save that which was lost". Zacchaeus was a good example of the lost that Jesus came to save, and he identified that even in the midst of praise, adulation and a crowd of followers.

There are many people that jump to solve problems but fewer that are authentic problem seers. People that constantly see the big picture and perceive hidden motives and intentions more than that which is obvious. We are called to listen behind the **words** being said. See behind the **actions** being performed and intuit behind the **energy** being experienced.

To become more of people that see through things, we need to start by aligning with the vision of God through spending time with him in prayer (Romans 8:27). And also spending time to study the Word of God so we may take the right steps according to his leading (James 1:25).

Another thing we can do is to learn to ask the right questions and not be comfortable with how things are and how they are done around us. We should be willing to express our God nature (as displayed in Genesis 1) by looking through darkness and chaos, and calling for light and new life, after all, in Isaiah 45:3, He promised that He will give us the treasures of darkness!

Vision has started to become a bit of a buzzword in the world of today. Everyone is coming up with a vision statement, every major company seems to have a vision they put on their website, and it does not matter if someone else apart from them came up with that statement and they are just copying it. It does not even matter if it just stays as a statement and never causes their organization or person to change in anyway. We can write things down as much as we want, label them vision and want them to come to pass. It does not mean anything would change in our lives. So, how do we ensure that we take our vision away from being mere wishes, hopes and statements but executed reality in our lives?

The first step is to know that what you have is enough. In the book of 2nd Kings, there was a widow that cried to the prophet on how their family was in debt and they did not know what to do. They were stuck and could not even envisage any sort of good future. The prophet Elisha asked the widow just one question in 2nd Kings 4:2, "So Elisha said to her, "What shall I do for you? Tell me, what do you have in the house?" And she said, "Your maidservant has nothing in the house but a jar of oil". And that oil was all that was needed to set her family free from poverty and bondage.

The opposite of more isn't less. It is gratitude. Being grateful for what we do have. This is the foundation for being able to appreciate and use everything we have been entrusted with wisely and is the most important step to actualizing vision. What do we presently have? Have you asked yourself that? Gratitude for what we possess, not only frees us from the grip of self, it makes us happier and able to properly articulate our vision which in turn drives the actualization of this vision.

Maybe you can relate? Anyway, I will leave you with the words I start my day with most times, "what you have is enough."

If you don't think so, take a look around you. Then take a look inside of you. Who you are is enough, too. God has given you all that you need and that which we think is weak in us is where He hastens to even show up. 2nd Cor 12:9.

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GOALS

Goal setting.

"Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Won't you first sit down and estimate the cost to see if you have enough money to complete it?"

Luke 14:28

The start of a new year is typically a flurry of resolutions by people and organizations around what they desire to achieve or see in the upcoming, however a process that impact outcomes at the end of the year is GOAL SETTING.

Four years ago, 2 colleagues of mine decided they were going to climb to the highest point on the African continent -Mount Kilimanjaro in Tanzania by February of the following year. One of them had attempted a couple of years earlier but didn't get to the summit, while the other was desirous of achieving this feat for his milestone anniversary. The goal was clear but experimentally at least for one of them, it was clear that getting to the top of that mountain was not going to "just" happen.

Among the first things they did was to share this goal with a few other colleagues, some of who signed up and then committed to process that would require some lifestyle adjustments, financial investments, time of study and research amongst many others over several months, while remaining accountable to the clear objective.

In the process of articulating what getting to the summit of Kilimanjaro, some of these colleagues realized that are other short-term goals and wins they needed to achieve and gained clarity through the discipline of planning.

It is not about the audacity of your goal, is more around your willingness to commit to making the audacious steps towards-Starting with goal setting. The journey to any worthwhile goal requires careful planning, study and actions which must be defined, measurable, challenging but realizable with a clear timeline to achieve. It is for this reason that no matter how interesting a football match can be played endlessly.

Our opening text is a clear call on the importance of determining upfront not just what we seek to achieve in this year but how intentional are we about examining what is required, when it will be required, how it will show up and definition of what success will look like. The process of goal setting will throw up ACTIONS which would cover from what to you need to Start, Stop or continue doing.

Whatever height you desire to scale this year, taking the time to dig-in in planning is a worthwhile investment, remember "The plans of the diligent lead to profit....." Proverbs 21:5

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Area of goal setting.

Businesses call it "Corporate Planning" and governments call this "Strategic National Planning" but the point is setting is not an event or some isolated activity but one that should cover every facet of life and living.

Where a business would have a goal to achieve a certain profitability benchmark, it would require intentionality across the various units to be aligned to this objective so that the teams needed to contain or reduce cost understands this, along with areas for greater productivity or sales.

As highlighted goal setting should be taken as an annual event but an integrated process that run from one period into another all towards ensuring your growth across all dimensions and one that should be prayerfully engaged in, recognizing that our God has the time and seasons in His sights.

So recall the team intending to climb Mount Kilimanjaro, the planning would impact Finances, they would need to plan time away from work or business, prepare their family for their absence, commit to study other climbers, the route and keep fit for the journey, this is how multi-dimensional goals setting is. Goals should be set across the following

1. Spiritual Growth
2. Personal Development
3. Finances
4. Career /Business/Professional Growth
5. Relationships
6. Health
7. Ministry

Across these 7 areas you would have covered significantly your God given aspirations for this year and beyond. This is true because these dimensions are very related in terms of how your financial goals supports your personal development which itself is impacted by the spiritual shifts and relationships you are cultivating, and I dare say letting off this season.

We are reminded in Ephesians 2:10 that as God's, fashioned in Christ Jesus to do good works, our default setting is to excel and thrive in doing good."

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Steps to answered prayers.

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

James 1:5 - 8

Praying according to the Word gets the Father's attention because He only responds to the language of His Word. It is your guarantee to getting results. You can count on it! We need to grow in our understanding of the ways of God and learn to recognize the voice of God when He is speaking to us. This can be through His written Word, through His voice speaking into our spirit, or even through dreams and visions as had become Daniel's experience.

Oftentimes, an unanswered prayer is not about God's unwillingness to respond but has to do with requests made with wrong motives or limited perspective. When praying, we should keep three things in mind:

- First, we must make wise requests. When we ask according to God's will, we have confidence that He'll answer our requests (1 John 5:14-15).
- Second, we should examine our motives. (James 4:3).
- Third, we should always trust God's perspective. Man sees glimpses only of the immediate future, but God can see everything at once. He's not slow about answering our petitions, because His timing is perfect (2 Peter 3:8-9).

Never give up on prayer, God is able to do much more than we can ever think or imagine.
